### MISSION STATEMENT:

St. Elizabeth Parent's Day Out Program - Early Childhood Development Center is committed to providing quality care in a safe, loving, Catholic Christian environment, allowing parents an opportunity to take time out, thereby building stronger families. We will work together developing positive structures and supports for children in a Christ centered way.

### PHILOSOPHY:

Our program's educational philosophy stems from the belief that all children should be able to grow through accomplishment and with a strong sense of self-worth, therefore, we believe children learn best through play. We offer a hands-on approach for children to learn about God and the world around them. We will strive to provide an environment which encourages this while recognizing individuality within the child. Children will be taught respect for others, as well as themselves, for it is through self-respect that children will be able to grow. We will make every effort to give children a strong foundation for learning – one that will stay with them through the remainder of their life.

### ABOUT OUR CLASSES:

Our curriculum is developmentally appropriate for children ages 2-5 years using the Wee Learn Curriculum. Classes have low teacher-child ratio. Teachers receive 24 hours of annual early childhood development training. Our school year is September through mid May. Classes meet from 9:00 am to 1:20 pm. Choices depend on child's age on September 1st. Classes are as follows:

\*\* All 4 year olds must be potty trained. 3 year olds in the 4 day class only must be potty trained by the first day of class.

\* Tuition is based on an amount for the year and broken up into 9 monthly payments for your convenience; therefore the amount remains the same regardless of the amount of class days in the month. Our program is a ministry of St. Elizabeth Church; therefore we offer a discount to registered parishioners who are contributing to the church in time, talent or treasure.

### ITEMS NEEDED AT REGISTRATION TO CONFIRM & HOLD YOUR CHILD'S SPOT FOR 2018-2019:

**REGISTRATION FEE:** All registration fees are non-refundable and due at time of registration.

Registration Fee will be a flat fee of **\$100.00 per family** (Parishioner and Non-Parishioner).

**SUPPLY FEE:** All supply fees are a one-time non-refundable fee and due at time of registration.

\$85/child for 2 day class      \$100/child for 3 day class      \$115/child for 4 day class

**ENROLLMENT FORM:** Forms must be completely filled out including emergency contact information with addresses & driver's license numbers, doctor information, etc.

### ITEMS NEEDED BY THE FIRST DAY OF CLASS:

**HEALTH STATEMENT:** A statement from your child's doctor saying they have been examined and are physically able to participate in a preschool program and that they are current on all their immunizations. We have a Health Statement form you may use or doctors can use their own. This may be turned into our office or faxed to: 512-251-9868; Attention: Kim Perales

**IMMUNIZATION RECORD:** Immunizations must be up to date. Current students do not need to turn in a new copy except to reflect newer immunizations.

**HEARING & VISION:** Results of a Hearing/Vision test are required for children at 4 years of age.

**All 4 Year Old students also need:** 1 three ring 1.5" white clear view binder  
1-2 packages of 8.5 x 11 cardstock, white or assorted colors

Each child brings their own lunch with a drink and needs a small blanket, towel or rest mat for rest time. Once every few months, your child will provide snack and one gallon of water for the whole class to share.
